If the pistol or high-power range is in use due to scheduled or posted events, you may use the smallbore range, but **do NOT** move frames from one range to another.

Walk-throughs for new members will only be held on the last Thursday of each month, April through September. They will no longer be on an individual basis. This will also apply to people who have let their membership lapse for more than 1 year.

If you are alone and going down range beyond 200 yds., be sure to activate the AMBERSTROBEWARNING LIGHTS. The switch is located on the post south of the light. Another indicator to be posted is the flag at the west end of slab
